Name: ALUSPRAY 4% cutaneous powder spray **Qualitative and quantitative composition:** Aluminium powder 4.0 % w/w. Excipients: Liquid paraffin 12.0 % w/w, Liquefied petroleum gas 84.0 % w/w. ALUSPRAY allows a fine mist of aluminium to be produced permitting complete covering of lesions. The film thus obtained affords good protection against dirt and insects. **Usage: Species:** Cattle, horse, swine, poultry, sheep, dogs and cats **Warnings:** Do not use in animals with known hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients. Do not use in animals suffering from severe renal impairment. Do not use on teat injuries in lactating animals producing milk for human consumption. **Special precautions for use:** - The product should be used unaltered from the original container. - In case of blockage of the spray nozzle, immerse it in hot water. **Use during pregnancy and lactation:** Do not use on teat injuries in lactating animals producing milk for human consumption. The product may be used in pregnant animals. **Interaction with medicaments and forms of interaction:** None. **Method of administration:** Shake well before use. Apply superficially to wounds once or twice daily, to produce a fine coating of the powder. For optimal use, wounds should be cleaned, disinfected and sutured if necessary before the application of ALUSPRAY. **Withdrawal periods:** Zero days - Animals may be slaughtered for human consumption following use. **Special precautions to be taken by the person administering the product to animals:** This product stains: avoid contact with hands and clothes. Wear gloves when administering the product, wash hands after use. Apply outdoors or in a well ventilated area. Do not swallow. Pressurised container. Flammable. Do not spray on or near a naked flame or any incandescent material. **Product Details:** Special precautions for storage: Do not store above 25°C. Protect from sunlight. **Nature and contents of container:** The product is packed in an aluminium 210 ml pressurised can equipped with a valve. **Special precautions for the disposal of unused product or waste material, if any:** Do not pierce or burn even after use. Any unused product or waste material should be disposed of in accordance with national requirements.

Aluspray allows optimum wound healing

Aluspray forms an aluminium powder barrier for wounds and sensitive skin

- ✔ The fine mist propelled means Aluspray completely covers the wound and can be applied without damaging the wound tissue.
- ✔ Aluspray contains a proprietary carrier that helps the protective formula to adhere to the skin, so it stays where its needed.
- ✔ Aluspray allows the wound to oxygenate (breathe) which is essential for good wound healing.



Aluspray is ideal for horses and other animals kept outdoors

- ✔ Aluspray can be used as a barrier during risk periods e.g. mud fever and increased sensitivity to sunlight
- ✔ Aluspray is permitted under FEI and HRA regulations
- ✔ Aluspray won't burn or blister sensitive skin

- ✔ Being waterproof Aluspray is highly suited for application to unhoused animals.



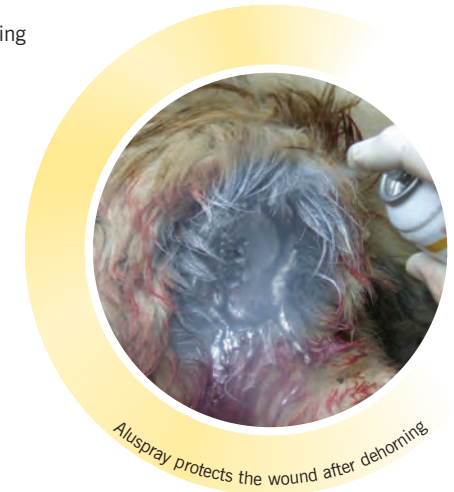
With Aluspray you're in control

- ✔ Unlike sprays with colour dye, Aluspray washes off easily with warm soapy water (or water and Hibiscrub) for inspecting the wound or for when the horse is able to compete.



Aluspray forms a protective barrier

- ✔ against moisture
- ✔ against micro-organisms e.g. bacteria and fungi including *Dermatophilus congolensis*, the causative agent of Mud Fever
- ✔ against dirt, flies and other insects
- ✔ for teat ends in dry cows only. It should not be used to cover teat injuries in lactating animals producing milk for human consumption.
- ✔ and shields sensitive skin from diarrhoea
- ✔ post castration
- ✔ post dehorning



Aluspray is easy-to-use

- ✔ The can design means it can be sprayed quietly, upside down and with accuracy to easily reach difficult areas.
- ✔ There is no antibiotic in Aluspray, thus overcoming any concerns over antibiotic residues in animals intended for food consumption.
